Gibbs High School (Business, Economic and Technology Academy)

In accordance with the Interinstitutional Articulation Agreement between the Pinellas County Schools' Board of Education and the St. Petersburg College Board of Trustees, this course to course agreement provides opportunities for students to receive college credit for appropriate work completed at the high school. St Petersburg College agrees to award college credit to students completing the following courses at Pinellas County Schools and transferring them to the Computer Networking program at SPC as specifically defined above.

Students will not be charged any fees for the awarding of hours covered by this agreement. A grade of "P" will be given for the college credit. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 in the subject area and an official CISCO Academy certification of completion per official CISCO CCNA courses will be required in the program before credit is issued. Students must enroll at SPC as a **degree seeking student** within **three (3)** years after graduation to be eligible to receive the articulated credit. This Career Pathway Articulation Agreement replaces any previously existing agreements relating to the aforementioned program

This agreement will be reviewed every three years.
