This course gives you a “real world” experience with major-related, supervised and evaluated practical work experience which can be paid or voluntary. You are graded on documented learning you gain through hands-on experience in a work setting. You must work at least 180 on-the-job hours for the 3-credit internship course.

Before you are enrolled in the internship course, you must meet the following internship requirements:

- Complete 80% of the General Education courses for the program
- Complete the program courses below and their prerequisites.
- Be in the fourth quartile of program completion during the semester in which the internship course is taken.
- Complete the [Internship Application](#) before the [application deadline](#).
- Secure an internship related to your major
- Submit internship placement details using [this form](#).

The following courses must be completed with a “C” or better prior to applying for an internship:

Once your placement is approved, the College of Computer and Information Technology will register you for the internship course.
