You earn a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Math (grades 6-12) Education and are prepared for certification in this area.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree or higher *and* a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.**

2) Completion of state-mandated prerequisite with a grade of C or higher:

- EDF 1005 Introduction to Education.
- MAC 2311 Calculus & Analytic Geometry
- MAC 2312 Calculus & Analytic Geometry
- MAC XXXX (4 credits of additional mathematics coursework with "MAC" prefix)

3) A cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).

Important General Knowledge Test Information

The **General Knowledge Test** must be completed within the first semester of the program. Completion of all four sections of the General Knowledge test will be required within the first semester of coursework for students to continue in this degree plan.

FRESHMAN
