ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This teacher preparation program combines college coursework related to English content, the pedagogy of teaching and practical, school-based experiences to prepare students for professional certification to teach English in grades 6-12. Graduates earn a **Bachelor of Science in Secondary English Education** and will be endorsed in both Reading and ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages).

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree and a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.**
- 2) Completion of state-mandated prerequisite with a grade of C or higher:
 - EDF 1005 Introduction to Education.
- 3) A cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).
- 4) It is highly recommended that students complete ENC 1102 prior to applying.
