Retention	Nineteen new first year students matriculated into the program this past January and fifteen remain for a retention rate of 79%.	We will have one first year and one second year student participate in the new student orientation for the cohort that enters the program in January of 2013. This will be done under the premise that sharing their experiences and insight into the program may improve the program's retention.
Second Year Class Update		
Retention	Twenty-two students matriculated into the program back in January of 2011 and eighteen remain for a retention rate of 82%.	The retention rate is above the program's benchmark of 75%, so no action is needed at this time.
Graduate Update		
Employment Results	There were seventeen graduates from the class of 2011. Fifteen of the graduates are gainfully employed within the field with a mix of part-time and full-time work. One graduate is not actively seeking employment and the last one is continuing his education. Therefore, the overall graduate job placement rate is 100%.	The employment benchmark is 75% however, we will continue to closely monitor graduate employment.
ARRT National Certification Test Results	All seventeen of the graduates from the class of 2011 passed the ARRT's national certification examination on their first attempt. The overall national pass rate for 2011 was 92.7%. The average national scaled score for 2011 was 85.1%. The State of Florida average scaled score was 83.8%. The SPC graduate average scaled score was 87%.	The program will continue to closely monitor ARRT test results.
