CCIT Update

Data Science Degrees

- Data Analytics subplan in the Bachelor's degree has been upgraded to Data Science.
- Dan Lueck helped greatly Upgraded Data Science subplan will be offered in Fall '19.
- Plan to have an AS in Data Science as well.
- Dan Lueck also helped with the creation of this degree not time intensive was able to complete his piece over one weekend.
- Data Science AS will be offered in Spring 2020.
- Dr. Stewart is asking for help defining degrees concentrating not only on academics but also fulfilling industry needs.

AR/VR Working with Calvary Christian High School

- Dr. Stewart is planning to work with Calvary Christian High School for AR/VR.
- Professor Shane Hamilton working with mixed reality.
- Need servers to run mixed reality, Provosts have helped with some of the funding.
- Dr. Stewart is looking for grants to help with additional funding.
- This mixed reality can be used to create applications for the Police Academy.
- Need more industry input.
- Tony suggested teaming up with Comp-TIA would be educational as well.

- Tony will introduce Dr. Stewart to his contact will discuss more after introduction.
- Dr. Stewart trying to move at the pace of business.

Web Development AS Degree

- Development of courses focused on accessibility for the blind/deaf.
- Instructing students how to integrate accessibility into websites.
- Tony suggested Freedom Scientific would be a great company to partner with on accessibility.

Partnership with Apple

- Apple has curriculum called Everyone Can Code.
- This curriculum teaches how to teach coding on Apple devices.
- Previously had iOS courses bringing Apple back, but will not be an Apple degree
- Setting up a Mac lab funded by Perkins.
- Dr. Stewart asked for recommendations from the committee for curriculum, employable skills to be taught.
- Tony will talk to his team, but suggested teaching framework best practice and coding best practice.
- Muslim suggested to send an email to the whole group to ask these questions

DJJ Parnership / Development of Gaming Programming Curriculum

- DJJ- Tallahassee created new program for at risk HS seniors ready to go in system.
- Students will use code combat and a Raspberry Pi.
- Students will keep Pi after the course is complete.
- We volunteered to have students at Gibbs.
- DJJ paid for 10 students to start this Spring term.
- Programming students are teaching the DJJ students (Interns).
- Program has been very successful.
- Awards celebration end of March.
- Motivate students to change ways.
- SPC / Dr. Stewart have been asked to co-present program in DC to all State DJJ Agencies.

ISC²

- Dr. Stewart met with ISC².
- Students who take boot camp at ISC² can articulate to courses in CCIT.
- Dr. Stewart to find out if CCIT can partner with ISC².
- Cybersecurity is in high demand and there is almost no unemployment.
- Students don't have \$5,000.00 to pay for bootcamp and employers would rather pay tuition reimbursement.
- Do not currently have certification articulations for BAS Dr. Stewart to investigate.

Blockchain Training

- Blockchain can be offered in workforce
- Will work on how to articulate into academic credit.
- CompTIA working on Block Chain as well, Dr. Stewart will contact for partnership opportunities.

BAS-Cybersecurity

- Have received approval to send a Letter of Intent.
- Letter of Intent should be sent in a week.
- Meet with BOT to present degree.
- If BOT approves can send application.
- Dr. Stewart needs to contact 3 local colleges to inform of intent.
- Once approved there are only 4 new courses to develop.

Skills at Work

- New Skills at Work grant has ended.
- SPC has re-branded to "Skills at Work" and brought the program into the college.
- Career Services is responsible for facilitating the program.

Apprenticeship Program Grant

- SPC is becoming a Registered Apprenticeship Program for IT.
- Students in the Apprenticeship Program will start with the helpdesk and move up.
- Dr. Stewart as members for help by taking on apprentices.
- Members stated HR is the issue why the apprenticeship has not taken off for IT.
- It was suggested to have someone from either SPC legal or HR attend meetings with Susan.
- Tony and Gabriel to connect after the meeting.
- Cisco Apprentice Program Representative and Susan Biszewski-Eber will meet to discuss opportunity.

Year-Up

- Work with economically challenged students in the Downtown area.
- 20 students in program
- Program will start Spring 2019 in 8 week 2.
- Currently recruiting Adjuncts.
- Program will consist of 4 classes.
- Year UP is considered pre-apprentice.
- SIM has chosen Year up as the philanthropic area for this year.

Internships

- Dr. Stewart would like to move toward project based internships.
- Achieva Credit Union will be first to take on a project based internship.
- Chris stated "Melitta has tried to get interns through Handshake only I person responded. (was for Business)
- Faculty key to student engagement they need to promote Handshake.
- Question why can't Handshake notify students?
- Dr. Stewart will investigate.
- Students do not want to search. Suggestion students will react to SMS messages sent to them with press I for Yes 2 for No.

Cisco Academy

- Met with regional sales person.
- Dr. Stewart wants to expand Cisco Academy.
- Cisco has Big Data course, Professor Ellis will subscribe to the course.

Marketing
