

Engineering Technology Advisory Board Meeting Minutes

4/7/2016

Meeting opened at 5:00pm.

1. Elect a Board Chair
 - a. The chair should be someone from industry and the two industry attendees requested the topic be tabled till more industry partners can attend
2. Program Update: Review revised engineering technology core frameworks
 - a. Every 3 years the state frameworks are reviewed by educators and industry partners. The state frameworks are the instructional guidelines used by educators to set learning objectives.
 - b. The engineering technology core frameworks were reviewed in September 2015 and then voted upon in April 2016 by Florida College educators. They now have to be reviewed by industry partners.
 - c. If you could not attend the meeting, Frameworks are available from Lara Sharp.
 - d. One correction was recommended and will be forward to Ted Norman in at the State DOE in Tallahassee. The recommendation was to add a benchmark under Standard 5 that says "Demonstrate knowledge of standard industry practices regarding quality management systems (eg. ISO 9000)".
3. Internships
 - a. Lara Sharp explained the guidelines a student has to meet with an internship in order to graduate.
 - i. 180 work hours during the semester
 - ii. Work can be temporary, part-time, or full-time
 - iii. The work done by the student must be in the field of study (electronics, medical quality systems, or computer aided design).
 - b. Jill Flansburg explained how CareerEdge and CareerSource can offer financial assistance to employers who hire an intern
 - c. Lara Sharp stated that there is always a need for internships.
