II. Minutes from Fall 2018 meeting

Stentiford

a. The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Cindy McNulty had an edit regarding the Trauma Informed Care. Cindy made a motion to approve the amended minutes. Teri Trede seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

III. Academic Community Events

IV. Milestones:

Trede

a. The milestones were reviewed and discussions were held about how these milestones help monitor how students are progressing through the program with intervention/promotion strategies along the way.

V. Update on AS-HSC program

Stentiford

a. The ASHSA program has transitioned to targeted subplans which are related to other health programs offered through the college. In addition, there are embedded certificates so that student have shorter milestones along the way to help them with employability skills.

VI. Update on BAS-HSA program

Trede

a. There has been an increase in enrollment in recent semesters and subplans expanded with a new CDI subplan starting in the Fall. Once students complete the CDI subplan, they can sit for a Certification exam. The subplan is applied to the HSA degree.

- b. Efforts are being made to create a BSA in RET which includes and advanced technical certification with RET specialties. An application needs to be made to the state.
- c. A new Capstone option is being developed for the students earning their BASHSA with a Respiratory Care Subplan targeted specifically for this specific student population.
- d. Approval has been given to hire another faculty member in the program to help serve the growing student population and expanded subplan options.
