## Introduction:

## Discussion:

- To improve the numbers, we need to focus on contacting high schools. There are six high schools in Pinellas County with hospitality programs. And we need to focus on marketing to businesses because it is the leading employer in Pinellas Co.
- We had a discussion on improving the numbers. We believe the numbers will improve once we hire an Instructor-in-Charge for the program. This person will have both academic and outreach responsibilities. They will be helpful in marketing the program to the local business community.
- We discussed the new revisions to the HFT curriculum. The board agreed that infusing business
  courses along with eight-week, online courses will enable students to complete the program
  faster. Also adding an Events Planning course will diversify the program. These changes along
