Vickie Grantham stated she has noticed that some of her classmates have increased academic difficulty due to a lack of computer skills. Student must complete coursework designed to develop or demonstrate computer proficiency, but this is not a pre req, and many students do not complete this until they are well into the program. Vickie suggested that the college may consider making this a pre req for the program, so that students have the necessary computer skills to succeed in the program before they enter the program. The program agreed to take the matter under further consideration.

Tracy Samuels mentioned that current indicators show that the strong demand for RT graduates will continue.

Steve Hardt mentioned that the program would like to improve its process for having potential students do clinical observations. Several options for improving the process were discussed. It was agreed that a new process could be developed and presented at the Spring Advisory Committee Meeting
