Student and Graduate Report

Sean Schlesman and Jake Hoss gave a brief student report. There are no issues to report at this time.

Proposed Growth Plan

Steve Hardt reviewed the justification for requesting 6 additional seats in the program from CoARC. A partial list of reasons include:

- Demand for graduates continues to remain very strong
- A year has elapsed since we completed our previous growth plan
- Just completed a very strong self-study and site visit
- It is better to have the available seats and not use them than to need the seats and not have them

Mark Pellman made a motion to request 6 additional seats from CoARC. Seconded by Todd Ringeisen. Motion Carried

Baccalaureate Program

The future of the baccalaureate in Tampa Bay was discussed. Steve Hardt mentioned that the plan to have Hillsborough Community College (HCC) develop online courses for a Collaborative baccalaureate program could not obtain the necessary approvals since HCC does not offer any baccalaureate degrees. However, SPC has agree to fund the development of 2 additional upper division Respiratory Care programs to move SPC closer to a BSRT.

In a previous meeting Todd Ringeisen had mentioned that CAP had begun to question some baccalaureate degrees as they did not contain enough credits in the sciences. Steve Hardt stated he had researched this and found interpretive guidelines from CAP that called for more science classes in baccalaureate degrees.

In a previous meeting, Michelle Maher asked about the actual difference between the two degrees (BAS vs. BSRT) to a working therapist. It was agreed after some discussion that while the differences are subtle, many students seem to prefer the BSRT. Steve Hardt reviewed a detailed proposed plan for a BASRT or BSRT (attached).

Steve Hardt also reviewed, in detail, 3 possible Advanced Technical Certificates (ATC) embedded in this degree.

After considerable discussion, a motion was made by Andrew Barnett to make a recommendation to SPC senior administration to proceed with offering this proposed degree and embedded ATCs. Seconded by Mark Pellman. Motion carried

Other items

Steve Hardt announced that Dan Craddock will be retiring on December7, 2018 after 42 years of service to the College. All present congratulated Dan and thanked him for his years of distinguished service.

Steve Hardt announced that Dean Rich Flora will retiring at the end of the year. All present congratulated Dr. Flora and thanked him for his years of service.

Steve Hardt asked the Board if they had any input, questions, or suggestions for improvement. None were offered at this time
