Priority dates

SPC's FAFSA priority deadline date for financial aid packaging Feb. 1
 Priority deadline date for admissions applications and materials (i.e. transcripts) for Full Term May 4

You may still enroll in classes if the application is received after this date; however, there is no guarantee transcripts will be evaluated prior to the beginning of Full Term.

Financial aid awarded date for FAS due date extension April 23

You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.

Tuition due dates

Universal due date for Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session April 23

If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.

Tuition Payment Plan

Online enrollment begins March 23
 0% down payment with 3 monthly payments and \$15 enrollment fee April 3
 33% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$15 enrollment fee May 1
 50% down payment with 1 monthly payment and \$15 enrollment fee May 15
 Last date to increase the payment plan balance May 15
 Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan June 1

Book line of credit

If you will have a remaining balance after tuition and fees are paid, you may use up to \$800 toward books and supplies.

Begins for all classes April 20
 Ends for Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session June 2
 Ends for enrollment in Second 8 Week Session only June 16
 Ends for enrollment in Express Session only June 30

Textbook credit

If you are only enrolled in classes with a later tuition date, you must pay your tuition in full by the date below to be eligible for this credit.

\$10 textbook credit March 25 - April 24
 Last date to use textbook credit June 23

Last day to withdraw with a grade of "W"

Know the consequences of this decision. If you completely withdraw from the college, you will be required to repay financial assistance funds. You must phone the SPC Call Center at 727-791-2485 as you are not able to totally withdraw from all classes in MySPC.

**These are projected dates. The Business Office sends refunds by electronic deposit to a Bank Mobile Vibe Account or your personal bank account. Select your refund preference for Bank Mobile at www.spcollege.edu/bankmobile. Students will begin receiving their financial assistance refunds if their financial assistance files are complete and awards are posted. Per Federal regulations, first-time, first-year Stafford borrowers cannot receive their first loan disbursement until 30 calendar days after the first day of classes.*

Due date extension

FAS due date extension June 25
This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package on or after April 23. If your financial assistance award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date. Students with an extended due date will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration and official transcripts will not be available until the balance is paid in full.

Verification	14 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation <i>Once complete, the verification item(s) will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.</i>
SAP Appeals	15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY <i>Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List. To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.</i>

Students will be notified by email if, during peak processing times, the benchmarks above have been revised.
