

Tuition due dates

The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration and official transcripts will not be available until the balance is paid in full.

Students will begin receiving their financial assistance refunds if their financial assistance files are complete and awards are posted. Per Federal regulations, first-time, firstyear Stafford borrowers cannot receive their first loan disbursement until 30 calendar days after the first day of classes.
