TUITION

Tuition Due Dates

Universal Due Date for Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session Apr. 16
If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.

Financial Aid Awarded Date for FAS Due Date Extension Apr. 16
You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.

FAS Due Date Extension June 26

This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package by April 16. If your financial aid award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date. If you have an extended due date, you will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. You may continue in the class, but you will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration will not be available until the balance is paid in full.

Online enrollment begins March 24

0% down payment with 3 monthly payments and \$35 enrollment fee (April, May & June) .. April 17

33% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$40 enrollment fee (May & June) May 8

50% down payment with 1 monthly payment and \$40 enrollment fee (June) May 16

Last date to increase the payment plan agreement balance May 16

Last date to decrease or terminate payment plan agreement balance June 18

SAP Appeals	15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY <i>Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List. To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.</i>

TOTAL WITHDRAWAL

Know the consequences of this decision. If you completely withdraw from the college, you will be required to repay financial aid funds. You must phone the SPC Call Center at 727-341-4772 as you are not able to totally withdraw from all classes through MySPC. Withdrawing from a class or all classes will negatively affect your Satisfactory Academic Progress calculations and could affect your ability to receive financial aid in the future.

Last Date to Withdraw from All Classes and Incur Repayment of Federal Financial Aid Funds

If you withdraw from all of your classes BEFORE or ON this date, you will be required to repay all or part of your federal financial aid disbursed in that term.
